# **Terms of Services**

## Updated: February 11, 2021

Physicians Laboratory Services, Inc. / Physicians Laboratory, P.C. ("PhysLab", "we", "our") offers a variety of laboratory testing services conducted by PhysLab or by its contractors, successors, assignees; or otherwise processed by and/or contributed to PhysLab.

The following Terms of Service ("Terms of Service") govern all use of (1) the <u>www.physlab.com</u> patient portal (the "Site"); and/or (2) any of the testing services offered by PhysLab made available through the Site (together with the Site, collectively the "Services").

Please review these Terms of Service as they govern your use of the Services. BY ACCESSING, BROWSING, OR USING THE SERVICES, OR BY CLICKING TO AGREE TO THESE TERMS OF SERVICE WHEN THAT OPTION IS MADE AVAILABLE TO YOU, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS OF SERVICE AND OUR PRIVACY STATEMENT, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, BINDING ARBITRATION. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE TERMS OF SERVICE AND OUR PRIVACY STATEMENT THEN PLEASE DO NOT USE OR ACCESS THE SERVICES.

Note that Section 22 of these Terms of Service contains a mandatory arbitration clause that requires the use of arbitration on an individual basis and limits the remedies available to you in the event of disputes or claims in connection with these Terms of Service or the Site.

#### 1. SERVICES

PhysLab is providing the Site to you so you can conveniently store, access and manage your laboratory results within your patient portal account on the Site. The information you store on the Site is not intended to be, and should not be used for advice, diagnosis or treatment purposes. Such information may not always be accurate or up-to-date. Information provided to you through the Site should not be regarded as medical or health care advice, diagnosis or treatment. Always seek the advice of your physician or other qualified health care provider with any questions you may have regarding interpretation of your laboratory test results, a medical condition or other health related issues. In the case of a health emergency, seek immediate assistance from emergency personnel. Never delay obtaining medical advice or disregard medical advice because of information you access on or through the Site.

PhysLab controls and operates the Services from its offices within the United States. Claims relating to, including the use of, the Services, PhysLab Content, and the Content contained herein are governed by the laws of the United States and the State of Nebraska, regardless of your country of origin or where you access PhysLab, and notwithstanding of any conflicts of law principles and the United Nations Convention for the International Sale of Goods. PhysLab and you agree that the exclusive jurisdiction for any claim or action arising out of or relating to these Terms of Service or your use of these Services shall be filed only in the state or federal courts located in Nebraska, United States of America, and you further agree and submit to the exercise of personal jurisdiction of such courts for the purpose of litigating any such claim or action that is not subject to binding arbitration as set forth herein. You expressly submit and consent in advance to such jurisdiction in any action or suit commenced in such court, and you hereby waive any objection that you may have based upon lack of personal jurisdiction, improper venue or forum non conveniens. If you do not agree, please do not use these Services. If you choose to access

these Services from another location, you do so on your own initiative and are responsible for compliance with applicable local laws.

While we are licensed in Nebraska as a clinical laboratory, not all jurisdictions require our Services to be subject to license. Therefore, we are not universally licensed by all state, federal, or international authorities for laboratory testing conducted for health and disease-related purposes. In addition, there are certain jurisdictions in which we do not offer our Services because we do not have required licenses. Do not use or attempt to use our Services if you live within such a jurisdiction.

Your access to or use of the Services constitutes your acceptance of all the provisions of these Terms of Service. Except as otherwise provided herein, these Terms of Service apply to any use of the Services, regardless of whether or not you submit a biological sample or not, including but not limited to (a) submitting biological specimen for testing and processing, (b) uploading a digital version of your information generated through processing of your biological specimen by PhysLab or by its contractors, successors, and assignees; or otherwise processed by and/or contributed to PhysLab ("Testing Information") and interacting with it on the Site, and/or c) creating and using a free PhysLab account without providing your biological specimen or Testing Information. In order to use the Services, you must first agree to these Terms of Service. You may not use the Services if you do not accept the Terms of Service. You can accept the Terms of Service by (i) clicking to accept or agree to the Terms of Service, where this option is made available to you by PhysLab; (ii) by accessing the Site and creating an account; (iii) placing an order; or by (iv) actually using the Services. In this case, you acknowledge and agree that PhysLab will treat your use of the Services as acceptance of the Terms of Service. In addition, when using particular Services, you shall be subject to any guidelines or rules applicable to such services that may be posted from time to time on the Site or otherwise made available to you. All such guidelines or rules are hereby incorporated by reference into the Terms of Service. PhysLab also may offer other services from time to time that are governed by different terms of service.

You may not use the Services or accept the Terms of Service if (1) you are not of legal age to form a binding contract with PhysLab, or (2) you are a person barred from receiving the Services under the laws of the jurisdiction in which you are resident or from which you use the Services. This applies whether you submit your own biological specimen, a biological specimen for anyone for whom you have legal authority to agree, otherwise provide your own Testing Information, create an account, or place an order.

In addition, if you contribute or otherwise provide your own Testing Information, you must be nineteen (19) years of age or older to agree to these Terms of Service on behalf of yourself or those for whom you have legal authority to agree. You must be at least 19 years old to purchase a test. To protect your privacy when you share your Testing Information with us, each adult who submits a sample must create his/her own account. You also certify that you aren't listed on any sanctions list published by the U.S. Departments of Commerce, Treasury or State, including, but not limited to the Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons List and the Denied Persons List. PhysLab retains the right to block or otherwise prevent delivery of any type of email or other communication to or from the Site as part of our efforts to protect the Site, protect our customers or stop you from breaching this Agreement.

PhysLab Services are for informational and educational use only. We do not provide medical advice or treatment services. You use the Service at your own risk. The Service does not constitute medical advice or treatment services and is not a substitute for seeking professional

medical advice and/or assistance. You should not rely on the Service as a substitute for qualified medical guidance.

The Services include access to the PhysLab public website and laboratory testing services, including the collection and analysis of your biological specimen. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, each new feature of the Site shall be subject to the Terms of Service. You acknowledge and agree that the Services are provided "AS-IS". You acknowledge and agree that the form and nature of the Services which PhysLab provides may change from time to time without prior notice to you. As part of this continuing innovation, you acknowledge and agree that PhysLab may stop (permanently or temporarily) providing some Services (or any features within the Services) to you or to users generally at PhysLab's sole discretion, without prior notice to you. You may stop using the Services at any time. You do not need to specifically inform PhysLab when you stop using the Services unless you are requesting closure of your account. PhysLab assumes no responsibility for the use of Services outside of these Terms of Service or other applicable terms.

In order to use the Services, you must obtain Internet access and provide all equipment necessary to make such Internet connection. You are solely responsible for providing such equipment. You acknowledge and agree that while PhysLab may set a fixed upper limit on the number of transmissions you may send or receive through the Services or on the amount of storage space used for the provision of any Service at any time, at PhysLab's discretion.

The Services are part of a private network operated by PhysLab for the convenience of PhysLab's users. It has been designed so that you may manage certain personal health-related information stored in your account. The laboratory test results released into your account may not constitute a complete record of all the tests performed at a PhysLab facility, or all the information we have about you in our systems. PhysLab releases laboratory test results into your account based on the demographic information in our systems submitted by you, your physician, or other providers and any persons to whom you have granted custodial rights over your account. In addition, please note that there may be a delay before certain laboratory test results are released into your account.

#### 2. USER REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

By accessing the Services, you agree to, acknowledge, covenant, warrant and represent as follows:

a. You understand that the information you learn from PhysLab cannot be relied upon as medical advice, treatment or diagnosis. You acknowledge that PhysLab urges you to seek the advice of your healthcare provider if you have questions or concerns arising from your Testing Information.

b. You represent that you are eighteen (19) years of age or older.

c. You understand that all your Personal Information will be stored in PhysLab databases and will be processed in accordance with the PhysLab <u>Privacy Statement and Notice of</u> <u>Privacy Practices, as applicable</u>.

You agree that you have the authority, under the laws of the state or jurisdiction in which you reside, to provide these representations. In case of breach of any one of these representations PhysLab has the right, in its sole discretion, to suspend or terminate your account and refuse any and all current or future use of the Services (or any portion thereof) and you will hold harmless, defend and indemnify PhysLab and its affiliates against any liability, costs, or damages arising out of the breach of these representations and warranties.

# 3. ACCOUNT CREATION, PASSWORD, AND SECURITY OBLIGATIONS

In consideration of your use of the Services, you agree to: (1) provide true, accurate, current, and complete Registration Information (as defined below) about yourself as prompted by the Service; and (2) maintain and promptly update the Registration Information to keep it true, accurate, current, and complete. #### 4. PHYSLAB PRIVACY STATEMENT AND DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

In order to use the Services, you must first acknowledge and agree to the <u>Privacy Statement</u>. You may not use the Services if you do not accept the Privacy Statement. The information contained on the Site, including all text, graphics, images, photographs, videos, illustrations, trademarks, trade names, service marks, logos, slogans and other content contained therein (collectively, the "Content") are copyrights, trademarks, trade dress or other intellectual property owned by, controlled by, or licensed to PhysLab or their respective owners, and are protected under both United States and foreign laws.

As a condition of your use of the Services, you represent and warrant to PhysLab that you will not use the Services for any purpose that is unlawful or prohibited by these Terms of Service. You may not use the Services in any manner that could damage, disable, overburden, or impair the Services or interfere with any other party's use and enjoyment of the Services. You may not obtain or attempt to obtain any materials or information through any means not intentionally made available or provided for through the Services.

# 8. MODIFICATIONS TO SERVICE

PhysLab reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, the Services (or any part thereof) with or without notice. You acknowledge and agree that (1) modifications may result in a delay for some of the PhysLab features or Services, and (2) PhysLab shall not be liable to you or to any third party for any modification, suspension, or discontinuance of the Services.

The Software (as defined below) that you use may from time to time automatically download and install updates from PhysLab. # 9. TERMINATION

This Terms of Service is effective until terminated by either party. We may terminate or suspend these Terms at any time without notice to you. Your notice should be sent, in writing, to PhysLab's address, which is set out on the Site, or online via info@physlab.com. If you provide notice online, PhysLab will call or send you an email asking you to confirm your request and your notice will be effective following receipt of confirmation from you.

We may terminate or suspend the Services at any time (and in conjunction therewith, your password and account(s)) with no notice to you for any reason.
