

System Requirements

The PhysLab Test Directory interface and deployed applications are tested with and support current versions of the following mainstream browsers on Windows, Mac OS, iOS and Android operating systems:

- Chrome (current version)
- Firefox (current version)
- Safari (current version)
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 11

While it is possible to access PhysLab Test Directory with some older browsers, we highly recommend using the current versions for optimal usability and security.

Certain older browsers such as IE 7 are blocked from accessing PhysLab Test Directory as they are known to cause security issues.

Session Cookies

PhysLab Test Directory uses session cookies for its operation. These cookies are removed when the users log out of the PhysLab Test Directory interface or DataPages. Most browsers have cookies enabled by default. Refer to your browser's documentation for information on enabling cookies.

JavaScript

PhysLab Test Directory requires the use of JavaScript. Some firewalls and high-security environments disable JavaScript. Keep in mind that PhysLab Test Directory adheres to highest security standards and encryption is enforced when working with the PhysLab Test Directory interface and is available for all DataPage deployments, so all account activity and data transfer is encrypted.
